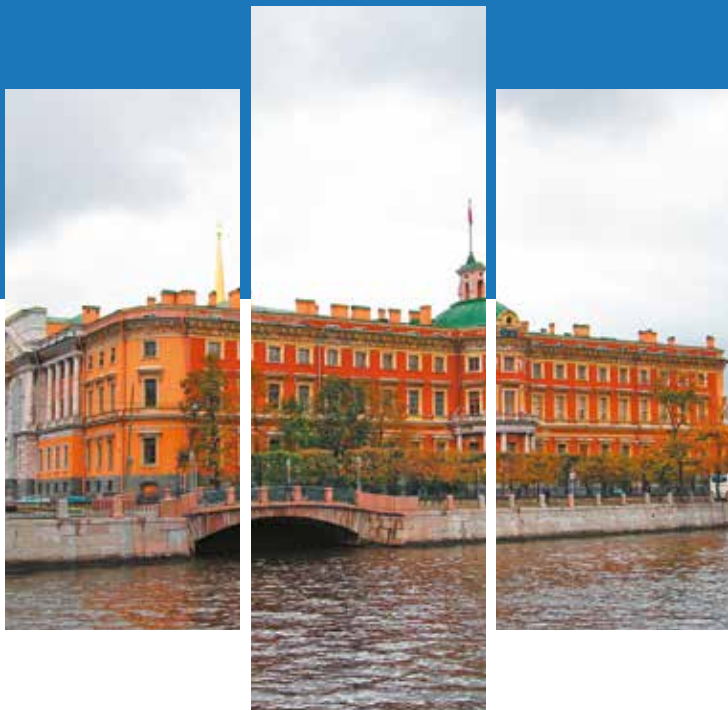


**Dear colleagues,

**A UNIQUE OPPORTUNITY TO SPEND A WONDERFUL
EVENING AT THE MIKHAILOVSKY CASTLE!**

A magnificent royal palace, which extravagant silhouette reminds medieval European buildings, is situated on the Fontanka river embankment. This is the Mikhailovsky Castle — the «fortress» of Emperor Paul I. The Castle is a manifestation of romantic medieval fantasy of the eccentric Emperor. Paul I was and still is one of the most extraordinary and mysterious figures in the Russian history. And his castle has a very similar fate, both their lives are wrapped in legends and myths.

The foundation of the palace was laid on February 26th, 1797. Two architects — Vasily Bazhenov and Vincenzo Brenna — officially worked on the project, but there was the third creator: there were rumours that the Emperor himself made several drawings. Even the unusual colour of the Castle walls appeared for a reason: according to the legend, the colour was chosen to match one of the gloves of Anna Lopukhina — Emperor's mistress — when she dropped it at the ball.



The guests will have a unique opportunity to visit one of the most mysterious palaces of Saint-Petersburg with a guided tour!
